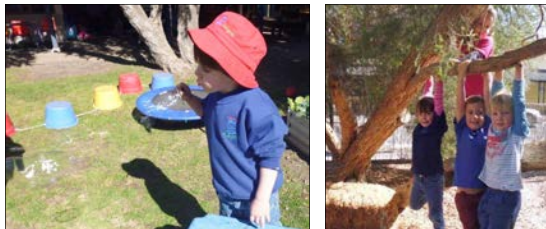

Early Childhood Services

The Partnership has four early childhood settings that offer a play-based approach to teaching and learning.

Nuriootpa, Tanunda, Angaston and Cambrai sites provide a range of care and preschool options. Individualised programs focus on authentic learning experiences for all children in engaging environments. Intentional teaching, and opportunities to learn through play exist at all sites. These help children develop a strong sense of self and belonging and promote positive attitudes for future learning.



Primary Schools

The six primary schools and one disability unit within the Partnership are able to offer a wide range of learning experiences due to location, size and focus areas. All DECD schools follow the Australian Curriculum and offer a variety of specialisations, including languages, which provide engaging, contemporary, challenging and student-centred learning programs.

Angaston, Light Pass, Tanunda and Tanunda Disability Unit, Nuriootpa, Keyneton and Greenock Primary schools form part of the Barossa Partnership and work closely together to meet the collective goals of the group. Community connections are strong for all schools and extra curricula activities form an important part of students' programs.



Area and High Schools

Cambrai Area School is a positive learning community, encouraging care and respect for the environment. We offer high quality, varied and appropriate educational opportunities for learners to participate, co-operate with others and persist in seeking success in their school life. Our school-wide expectations are *Be Respectful, Be Responsible, Be Safe, Be a Learner*. The school caters for students from R-10, and incorporates a Child Parent Centre.

Nuriootpa High School builds on the strong foundations of primary school to develop informed and socially conscious young people through a broad and challenging curriculum and extensive extra curricula program. A strong academic program is complemented with industry focused VET courses and the regional Disability Unit to ensure all students have every opportunity for success.
