We do, however, have the fantastic opportunity to all be involved in the filming of a video clip for the song 'Raining on the Plains'. This is planned for Tuesday June 30 but will be confirmed in a week or two.

Our students will be doing bursts of short movements (all instructed on the day) e.g. all jump, clap along with the song, running with and through fabric, making shapes and patterns in the playground, while they are filmed using standing cameras as well as a drone.

The movie is not for sale and will be shared with affiliated Department for Education school communities in Term 4.

There will be no names of individual children but our school name and logo will be in the credits of the movie.

Students are to be in normal school uniform/colours and we will treat the day as if it were school photo day - students are to have neat and tidy hair and clean uniform.
