We've just been awarded
a Woolworths Junior
Landcare Grant!



We've been successful with our application for a 2021 Woolworths Junior Landcare Grant for our project, KPS wicked bees and bush tucker. The expected (environmental and educational) outcomes of the project include connection to Indigenous foods, conservation of local endangered plant species, habitat for bees and other beneficial insects.

Keyneton Primary is one of 1,609 primary schools and early learning centres throughout Australia receiving a Woolworths Junior Landcare grant to help grow our next generation of environmental champions.

The grants are being funded with a 10c contribution from each sale of the Woolworths Bag for Good at full price, which was launched in 2018 when Woolworths went single-use plastic bag free.

The children and teachers are looking forward to working and learning from this project and we'll keep you updated on the results. This links to our school's project details directly
