PUPIL FREE DAY

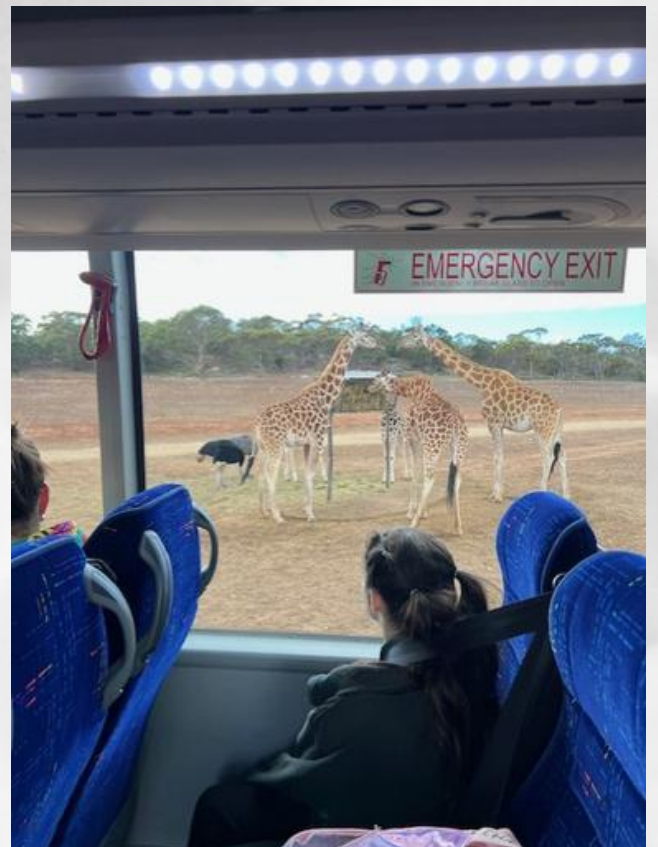

6. Take time to laugh and have fun too.



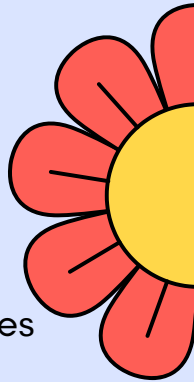

Are you between 8 and 12 years of age and would like to learn about surviving out in the environment? Join us for one or both Bush School sessions during the next school holidays.

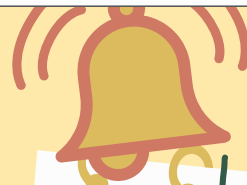
